Headlines

- Whilst attainment has improved to significantly above national, value-added at KS1 is below national for Barnet as a whole
- Higher performing (value-added) partnerships at KS1 still only perform broadly in line with national
- Partnership 6 should be a key focus at KS1 because attainment and value-added is significantly below national across a range of their schools in all subjects: Coppetts Wood Primary School is a relative strength in 2015
- At KS2, Partnership 2 has consistently lower progress rates (relatively) compared to other partnerships in Barnet across every subject
- Progress in Writing at KS2 should remain a key focus as multiple partnerships have lower value-added compared to national at both 2 and 3 levels of progress
- Partnership 6 at KS2 remains relatively lower performing (value-added) but has
 demonstrated improvements over the past 3 years. Schools which have improved the most
 within the partnership are Holly Park and Coppetts Wood.
- Partnership 12 should also be considered a focus at KS2 due to the lowest attainment and relatively low progress when compared to other partnerships in Barnet.
- More detailed analysis of some of the highlighted partnerships (either due to high/low attainment or progress) has shown that within each partnership, <u>based on 2015 data only</u>, there are strengths and weaknesses, and partnerships should undertake their own detailed analysis of their attainment and achievement to raise standards across all schools.

Only the rows lower attainers, FSM (in last 6 years), Non-SEN and First Language not English have been colour coded. Partnerships which are well below¹ national have been highlighted in green, and partnerships well above¹ the national level have been highlighted in amber.

Key Stage 1

Although Barnet's attainment at level 2+ rose, value-added across all subjects fell due to pupils not making enough progress to the level 2B+ and 3+ when compared to pupils with similar prior attainment. Partnerships 10 performs consistently well in terms of attainment being in line with Barnet and progress being strong, and ConnectED perform consistently well in terms of pupil progress.

Level 2+ Reading Writing and Maths

Barnet's attainment increased from 85% to 88%, demonstrating positive value added progress. Partnership 6 has shown consistent negative value-added progress for the past 3 years. In 2015, the greatest value-added was demonstrated by ConnectED's partnership.

Attainment and progress is based on provisional results.

Although Barnet's attainment fell slightly across a number of measures, pupil progress remains significantly above national (FFT significance tests). Attainment is generally highest in Partnerships 7 and 9, and these – along with Partnership 4 – show consistently the highest value-added across all measures. Partnership 6 shows generally lower attainment and progress across all measures although there have been improvements in the proportion of pupils making expected and more than expected progress in Reading and Maths. A lower proportion of pupils than national in Partnership 2 achieved more than expected progress across all subjects; this may be due to significantly higher attainment at KS1 in this partnership.

Level 4+ Reading, Writing & Maths

Barnet's attainment decreased from 83% to 82%, although value-added remains positive. Partnerships 4 and 5 demonstrated the strongest value-added in 2015; whilst Partnership 6 has consistently demonstrated negative value-added.

Summary

Key Stage 1

Barnet's progress at KS1 is significantly below national across all subjects. Partnerships 1, 10 and ConnectED's pupils progress at the same rate as similar pupils nationally across all subjects. In Reading, Partnership 10 has shown a consistent increase in the progress of their pupils over the past 3 years. In Maths Partnership 11 has shown a consistent increase in the progress of their pupils over the past 3 years.

At Key Stage 1, Partnership 6 has the lowest value-added across all KS1 subjects, and attainment in all subjects is below the Barnet average: however their attainment increased significantly across all subjects in the past academic year. Within Partnership 6, Coppetts Wood's attainment increased significantly in all subjects and their value added was highest in every subject.

Barnet's attainment (results) at KS1 significantly increased in 2015. Partnership 7 and Partnership 9 have the highest attainment overall, but their progress rates are below national in all KS1 subjects (Partnership 7's value-added is in line with national in Reading). Partnerships 7 and 9 both have amongst the lowest rates of FSM6 and low prior attainers based on pupils' attainment at EYFS. Partnership 7 also has lower than national EAL rates. Although attainment is strong, and progress is not significantly below national, there are areas of weakness in each partnership.

Partnerships 12 and ConnectED have the lowest attainment overall, and whilst Partnership 12's progress is slightly below national in all subjects, ConnectED is the only partnership to have a value-added either in line with or above national in each subject. Partnership 12 and ConnectED have the highest rates of FSM6 and EAL². ConnectED also have the highest proportion² of SEN pupils. In ConnectED, The Orion Primary School and Rosh Pinah show significantly positive progress for all subjects. In Partnership 12, Bell Lane is a relative strength, with attainment in line with or above national and significantly positive value-added in all subjects. A number of schools show both significantly low attainment and significantly low value-added across all subjects.

Key Stage 2

Barnet's attainment and value-added at KS2 is significantly above national in every subject. Partnership 2 has the lowest value added, although the progress is still slightly above national. Brookland Junior and Garden Suburb Junior are relative strengths, with attainment and progress rates strong across all subjects.

Partnership 6 has shown consistent improvements in value-added over the past 3 years: Holly Park is now significantly above national for value added in all subjects. Coppetts Wood's VA also increased a lot and is now significantly positive in Reading and Maths. All Saint's N20's attainment improved in all subjects and value-added improved from being significantly negative in Writing and Maths to being slightly below national.

Partnerships 5 and 9 have the highest value-added; Partnership 5 has positive VA across all subjects for nearly all schools. In Partnership 9 value-added is significantly positive for all subjects at Akiva, Manorside and St Theresa's. Most of the other schools in that partnership also show positive VA.

At 2 levels of progress, Partnerships 4, 5, 9 and 11 perform consistently amongst the highest for value added in every subject, whilst Partnership 2 is the only partnership to have negative value added (in Maths, and in line with national for Writing). Partnership 12 also has relatively low value added for two levels of progress in all subjects, being in line with national in Writing and Maths.

Progress (2 levels +) in Writing is an area where multiple partnerships (Partnerships 6, 8 and 10) show negative value-added: however, within each of these partnerships there are at least 2 schools where 100% of pupils achieved 2 levels of progress and should be able to share good practice. Writing is also an area of weakness for a number of partnerships at 3 levels of progress: Partnerships 2, 6, 8 and ConnectED had negative value-added in Writing. At 3 levels of progress, Partnership 2 had negative value-added in Reading.

Partnerships 7 and 9 are the highest attaining partnerships at KS2 (same as at KS1), and have the lowest proportion of low prior attaining pupils and FSM6 pupils (Partnership 7 also has the second highest² proportion of SEN pupils). Partnership 12 is the lowest attaining partnership (as is the case at KS1), followed by Partnership 5 and ConnectED. Partnerships 5 and 12 have the higher

proportions of low prior attainers and FSM6 pupils² and all 3 partnerships have the highest rates of EAL pupils in the Borough. ConnectED has the highest rate of SEN pupils in the borough².

In Partnership 12, attainment was lowest, but the progress was also relatively the lowest across all subjects when compared to all Barnet partnerships. Menorah Primary is strength of the partnership with attainment and progress significantly above national for every subject.

Summary of Partnership Capacity

This is a very high level analysis of performance and capacity issues for individual schools within each Partnership, based on 2015 data only. This data has been extracted from the overview page of FFT Aspire, which provides an indication of significantly higher/lower performing schools based on overall measures only (APS / and value-added for APS). Only significantly high or low performing schools in 2015 in the particular measures have been included, so other schools with higher or lower attainment/achievement in each partnership may exist but be excluded from this table due to the size of the cohort. This table is unlikely to flag all potential issues (e.g. a subject-specific issue for a particular school, or an issue in performance of pupil groups) but should provide an indication of the capacity of partnerships to promote school improvement within their current performance. Partnerships are highlighted amber if they don't have any schools within them that, based on 2015 data, have higher attainment and/or progress.
