


### Early Years Foundation Stage: SEN Pupils




#### Successes:

- FSM gap narrowed at a greater rate than London and national
- The Black Pupil attainment gap (against the Barnet average) narrowed by 5pp from 2013 to 2014
- Attainment of EAL pupils were above London and England

### Areas for Development:

- Attainment of SEN pupils without a statement fell by 1pp from 2013 to 2014, whilst attainment increased for these groups across London and nationally (by 7pp and 5pp respectively) but still above London and National
- A lower proportion of Black pupils attained a GLD compared to London, however we are now above the England average (last year we were below) and we have improved by 10% year on year compared to 8% for London and England and are now just 1% below the London average instead of 3%
- The attainment gap for EAL pupils increased from 9pp in 2013 to 12pp in 2014 (wider than London and national)















### Key Stage 1 Attainment








- School Action and School Action Plus pupils do not make as good progress as expected from EYFS to KS1
- Black Caribbean and Black African pupils are significantly less likely than nationally to attain the expected level at KS1 and make expected progress in Reading, Writing and Maths
- Although attainment of SEN School Action and School Action Plus pupils is significantly above pupils nationally, they should actually be doing better relative to their starting points

### Key Stage 2 Attainment
















% Attaining Level 4+ in KS2 RWM

### Key Stage 2: % Level 4+ RWM - Ethnic Group





In 2014, Black pupils in Barnet attained below Black pupils across London and in line with those nationally. The difference in attainment gaps between Barnet Black pupils and London and National Black pupils have closed significantly.

In Barnet, Black pupils are the only ethnic group (of the five groups identified in DfE data) to attain below the Barnet average

- Most pupil groups make significantly good progress, and more progress than expected in Barnet
- Value-Added for SEN statemented pupils in Writing and Maths is significantly below national
- The Value Added for mobile pupils is significantly below national relative to their starting points in Writing
- Black African pupils are less likely to make expected progress in Writing

# Key Stage 2 Summary

### **Successes**

- Results in all subjects rank in the top 25% nationally
- Attainment of nearly all pupil groups is significantly above national, including middle and low attainers, FSM and FSM6 pupils, EAL pupils, and SEN groups.
- In 2014, attainment of Black pupils improved significantly
- FSM and FSM6 gaps have narrowed the Barnet attainment gap is now in line with the London attainment gap and smaller than national

### **Areas for Development**

- 6pp attainment gap for EAL pupils (no attainment gap across London)
- Progress of statemented pupils in Writing and Maths
- Progress of Black African pupils in Writing



- Most pupil groups attain significantly above national by KS2
- Barnet's FSM and FSM6 gaps have narrowed the Barnet FSM and FSM6 attainment gap is now in line with the London attainment gap and smaller than national

**Overall Areas for Development** 

- Black Caribbean and Black African pupils consistently attain and achieve below the Barnet and London average
- Barnet ranks in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quartile for Phonics, and 3<sup>rd</sup> quartile for all KS1 subjects, and is below that of statistical neighbours
- Barnet EAL pupils attain below London average at KS2
- EAL gap at EYFS increased to 12% (London 8%, national 10%)
