London Independent Visitors

A befriending service for children and young people in care



What is an independent visitor?

An independent visitor is an adult who volunteers to spend some free time regularly with a young person like you, making friends with them and encouraging them with their interests. They are not paid to do this.

They are there to listen to you and to help you to talk and think about everyday things. They may have interests or hobbies they can share with you, or you can find new ones together.

What an independent visitor does:

They will usually visit once or twice a month, mostly at weekends. They can come to have a chat, go for a walk and give you the opportunity to try new activities or go to new places. They can also help you with your school work, if you like. They can even go to a review or meeting with you, so you have someone to stand up for you and help you get your views heard.

Who makes the decisions?

You and your independent visitor will have a written contract that says what you are likely to do and how often you meet. It's up to you both what you do with your time together, but the independent visitor will probably need to talk with your carer and others about arrangements.

Information we will keep about you:

In order to run a scheme like this, we need to keep a file with information about you. We do not let anyone see it apart from staff who work at Action for Children. If you want to see it, you can contact us and we will arrange it for you.
